

LIST OF RECOMMENDED MATERIALS

PROGRAM: ACRYLIC PAINTING FOR KIDS

- Canvas (Stretched or Canvas Panel)
 - Recommended size: 9 x 12 inches
 - 8 pieces (for class exercises)
 - You can purchase extra canvas for your child's own exploration

- Required Acrylic Paint Colors (At least 75mL)
 - Black
 - White
 - Blue
 - Red
 - Yellow

- Pencil & Eraser

- Paint Brushes - 1 set of nylon flat brushes with different sizes

- Palette or Mixing plate
Note: You can use an old plastic container or acrylic (household) plate

- 1 water container (cut recycled plastic bottles are preferred)

- Easel

- Rags

- Apron or oversized shirt

- Fan or Hairdryer (to help speed up the drying time of paint)

Additional Notes:

- Acrylic paint can be scraped off on surfaces like tiles, glass and acrylic glass, but will forever stain surfaces like cloth, wooden tables and chairs.

- You may opt to put a protective cover on the table or surface the kids will be painting on. Examples of protective covers are: newspaper, saran or cling wrap, and large plastic bag.
